refuel after a long, hot summer. Weed Man's exclusive fertilizer feeds your lawn as it needs it. It will also help grass plants store valuable nutrients for the cooler months ahead, aiding in the cold hardiness of your turf. Our technicians are fully trained to apply the right amount of product at the right time of the season to ensure that your lawn grows green and healthy come springtime.

MONITOR YOUR LAWN'S THIRST. Remember: your lawn needs about 1" of water per week to thrive. During the usual temperature drop that takes place in October and November, homeowners often find it difficult to maintain a balanced watering regimen. One of the biggest issues that arises is overwatering, which can lead to fungal diseases. As a general cooler season rule, you should only water your lawn when it needs it. Therefore, if there has been a return of regular rainfall after a summer of dry weather, then it is important to scale back watering or cut it out altogether (especially once the ground becomes frozen). On the other hand, extremely dry fall conditions call for continued watering to keep your lawn healthy.

WINTERIZE YOUR IRRIGATION

SYSTEM. Don't forget to turn off the outdoor water supply. Winter conditions can freeze the water inside of faucets and pipes, leading to bursting pipes and flooding inside of the home. We suggest using compressed air to remove all remaining water in the system.

RAKE & BAG LEAVES.

Colourful leaves sure are beautiful, but they can quickly cause more trouble than they're worth. Leaf coverage restricts the amount of oxygen and sunlight that reach your lawn's surface. It can also lead to overly-wet conditions that invite fungal diseases to take flight. Make it a family project to head outside and rake the yard one last time before winter hits.

LET YOUR SOIL BREATHE. Some areas experience matted-down grass, sparse growth, pooling water, and a hard ground that is uncomfortable to walk on - all signs you need to aerate. Mechanical core aeration loosens soil and thatch, increasing the movement of oxygen, water, and nutrients to the lawn's root zone.

REPAIR YOUR LAWN WITH OVERSEEDING. Repair bald areas of turf now to ensure a thicker, fuller lawn come springtime. New seed applied to the lawn will help eliminate bare spots, re-establish your lawn's strong foundation, and progressively improve its overall health and appearance. For best results, keep the soil consistently moist by watering two to three times a week until the new grass is firmly established.

LEVEL YOUR LAWN. If you've noticed dips or holes in the surface of your lawn, it's best to address these before winter sets in. Simply blend planting soil with compost and/or sand and pour the mixture into any unlevel areas.

MOW REGULARLY. The growing season can (and often does!) continue well into late fall, so be sure to mow regularly until growth ceases .This will ensure the lawn doesn't grow overly long and shade itself, which can impede photosynthesis and limit food production.

MOW LOW FOR YOUR LAST CUT OF THE YEAR. When you are ready to retire your mower for the year, lower your mower deck to the lowest height recommended for your turf. This will help prevent matting during cool, wet weather and keep disease pathogens at bay. It will also help your turf resist snow and ice damage.

Mowers and Trimmers: Every self-proclaimed lawn care aficionado needs a high-performing lawn mower and trimmer. The problem? 

With the winter season upon us, your turf has likely entered a state of dormancy, or is well on its way of doing so. Your lawn knows how to take care of itself during the cold weather seasons – it will go dormant and turn brown in order to conserve water. In other words, your lawn goes into hibernation mode. However, while your grass is taking a break, it's important that you respect it just as you would in the spring or summer. Respecting your lawn now will ensure a quicker green-up come the spring.

QUENCH ITS THIRST

If it rains or snows regularly where you live, winter watering isn't something you'll have to worry about. But if your turf isn't receiving at least an inch of water each week, you may want to consider a light watering to keep it from drying out and dying.

AVOID WALKING ON YOUR LAWN

Believe it or not, walking on your lawn when it's dormant and covered in snow, can cause damage to the grass and ultimately, kill it. Minimizing foot traffic on your lawn as much as possible will ensure a healthier lawn come the spring. Of course, we're not discouraging snowman-making or snowball fights, but try to keep the fun stuff for the backyard where a quick green-up isn't as important.

KEEP IT CLEAN

When it's cold outside and we don't go outdoors very often, it's easy for items to be left on the lawn; but leaving toys and patio furniture on the grass over the winter can be damaging to your turf. It can cause large dead spots and in the spring, the area affected will be an eye sore compared to the rest of your lawn. Not to mention, it will take more work to help bring that grass back to life!



HOW TO FIND

Picking the Perfect Tree

- 1. Be Prepared: First, pick a location in your home for your tree somewhere close to an outlet but far enough from any potential fire sources. As a general rule, you'll want to keep your tree about a foot shorter than the ceiling height, too, especially if you're going to be using a tree topper.
- 2. Focus on the Best: While all types of trees have their advantages and disadvantages, certain classes are known for their excellent needle retention, holiday scent, and shapeliness. These include: Fraser fir, balsam fir, Douglas fir, noble fir, and Scotch pine. Keeping your shopping trip focused on these superior tree types can save you time and money in the long run.





- **3. Don't Settle for Dryness:** To test a tree for freshness, run your hand over the needles or shake the tree. A fresh tree will hang on to its needles, while a dry tree will shed quickly and frequently.
- **4. Remember the Base:** Too many tree shoppers forget how important the base of the tree is. While not all trunks are created equal, you'll want to choose a tree with a relatively straight, flat base otherwise your tree may not maintain its sturdiness when placed in a stand. When you purchase your tree, request to have an inch or so taken off the base to help with water intake.
- **5. Travel Smart:** Many arrive home after tree shopping to discover a nasty surprise the tree that looked so perfect on the lot is no longer up to their standards. This often occurs when a tree is not wrapped properly for travel or has been stuffed hastily into the back of a vehicle. A large vehicle (or secured roof top rack) and mesh netting are recommended.
